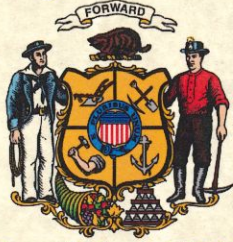

*WHEREAS*; this month, the state of Wisconsin recognizes the records and information management professionals working across the state and thanks them for the critical services they provide;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim April 2025 as

### RECORDS AND INFORMATION MANAGEMENT MONTH


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all our state's residents.
