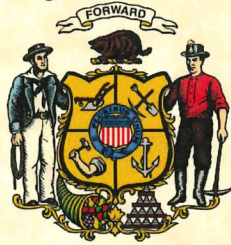

*WHEREAS*; the need to use information to create value and plan strategically is a driving force in today's world; and

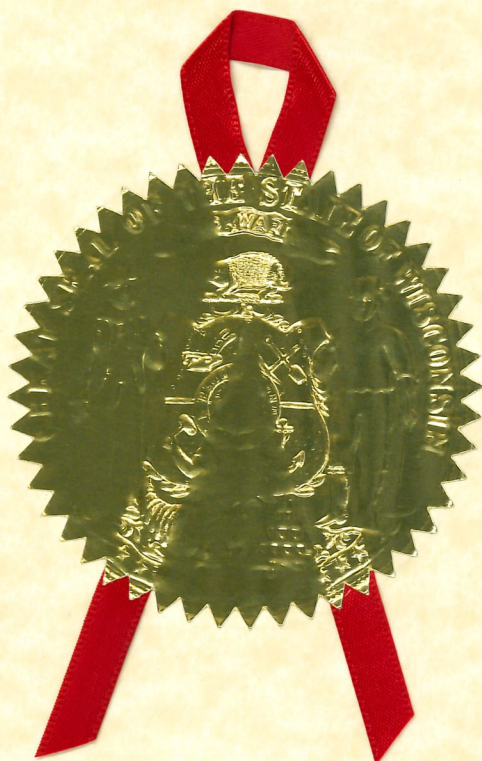
*WHEREAS*; control of records and information is necessary for reduction of risk and liability, as well as for compliance with global standards; and

*WHEREAS*; this month, the state of Wisconsin recognizes the records and information professionals working across our state and thanks them for the important services they provide;


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim April 2021 as
